

Rape Response Prevention Educator Part-Time Contract Position

Position requires:

- Prefer Bachelor's degree (or current enrollment in college working toward a bachelor's degree) in education, human service field, psychology, social and behavioral sciences, or related field
- Experience/comfort working with teenagers
- Experience/comfort working in education
- Ability to respect and maintain confidentiality
- Ability to work with other educators on the Prevention Education team
- Ability to work effectively with people from all socio-economic, religious and cultural backgrounds
- Ability to work a flexible schedule
- Excellent organizational skills
- Ability to compile feedback on programming and respond with any appropriate changes
- Computer skills to include Word, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint

This program is a priority for Rape Response throughout the six county service area: Dawson, Forsyth, Habersham, Hall, Lumpkin and White Counties.

Prefer: Experience in public speaking/education

Compensation: This is a grant funded part time independent contractor position, classes vary weekly and are heavier during the school year. Majority of classes scheduled weeks-months ahead of time. Flexibility for students in Graduate Programs.

Contract educators are paid \$30 per each class taught (typically 4 classes on scheduled days, occasionally up to 6 classes) and receive a mileage reimbursement (2023 rate .655 per mile traveled to each school in our six-county service area.)

Background checks are required.
